WHAT IS THE EREBB LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATE?

The EREBB Leadership Certificate is an international online course developed by Edmund Rice Education Beyond Borders (EREBB), Edmund Rice Schools Trust (ERST) in Ireland, and Marino Institute of Education (MIE).

The EREBB Leadership Certificate has been developed to support teachers, educators, leaders, and those aspiring to leadership in Edmund Rice schools and educational communities to become advocates and proponents of inclusive and liberating education practices.

This interactive 20-hour course consists of four modules of self-directed learning, which participants can complete in their own time and at their own pace. The course is moderated by MIE staff in Dublin, Ireland. Course participants will receive an EREBB Leadership Certificate.

- ✓ **Studied** the history and heritage of Edmund Rice, and how charisma is a way of being and quality of care and presence inspired by the Gospel message in response to the needs of contemporary culture
- ✓ **Explored** what Edmund Rice Education and Values are and how they apply in the current global context
- ✓ **Understood** what spiritual leadership is and how to lead in religiously diverse contexts
- ✓ **Engaged** with issues pertaining to social justice, advocacy and human rights, and particularly explored how schools and education in general can advocate on these issues

EREBB has established six priority action areas:



EREBB is an international network of Catholic schools educating young people from many different faiths and cultures. EREBB was inaugurated in May 2014 when leaders representing Edmund Rice Education, including Edmund Rice Schools Trust in Ireland, gathered in Nairobi, Kenya to establish an inclusive international network of Edmund Rice educational communities inspired by the teachings of Jesus, Gospel values, and the spirit of Edmund Rice. Today, EREBB is active in over 20 countries worldwide, promoting and supporting global solidarity with transformational education as a driver for justice and liberation for all.

Marino Institute of Education in consultation with Edmund Rice Schools Trust identified Inspiring Leadership and specifically Professional Development as the priority focus for its contribution to and support for EREBB's shared vision. With this in mind, MIE and ERST have spearheaded a collaboration of leading Edmund Rice educators around the world to design and develop the EREBB Leadership Certificate.

MARINO INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION

Marino Institute of Education is a teaching, learning and research community committed to promoting inclusion and excellence in education. It is a higher education institution with a singular focus on education and is an associated college of Trinity College Dublin.
